Brief introduction of XAUAT

XAUAT is widely recognised as one of China's most influential universities in the field of civil engineering and architecture. XAUAT has the disciplines of civil engineering, architecture, environment science and material science as its characteristic specialties, engineering as the major discipline, and also other disciplines such as liberal arts, sciences, economics, management, art and law.

At present, the university has 16 schools and departments offering 60 undergraduate programmes to students in China. Apart from the 3 disciplines of architecture, city planning and landscape science which offer a five-year curriculum, the remainder of the disciplines provide a four-year undergraduate programme. The university has about 40,000 students, including more than 20,000 undergraduates, over 7,000 postgraduates, and about 14,000 students in College of Continuing Education & College of Vocational Technology. XAUAT has 7 centres for post-doctoral studies in architecture, civil engineering, environmental science and engineering, material science and engineering, urban and rural planning, landscape architecture, and management science and engineering.

Requirement on UK institution partners

- The potential partner needs to be a UK-based university
- The potential partner needs to be a leading UK university either with a high reputation or expertise in certain subject areas.
