Brief introduction of Guangzhou University of Chinese Medicine

Established in 1956 as one of the first 4 Chinese Medicine higher education institutes in China. Guangzhou University of Chinese Medicine (GZUCM) is among the first group of universities to award Master and Doctoral degrees. As the key university in Guangdong Province, it ranks top academically and offers an unmatched comprehensive capacity among Chinese Medicine universities.

Located in Guangzhou, GZUCM rivals the best schools in medicine, Chinese Medicine Science, and Chinese Medicine Pharmaceutics. It currently has 10 research institutes and development centres and 15 schools. The university also owns 4 affiliated hospitals in Guangzhou.

Other information

As one of the most developed cities in South China, Shenzhen city has been relatively behind in terms of higher education. The city only hosts one university and aims to establish 10 international universities or colleges or joint institute in the near future.

GZUCM is one of the candidate Guangdong-based universities to run a joint institute in Shenzhen. With the great supports from the local government, as well as the financial funding and the established property resources, the GZUCM is now looking for a UK partner for a long-term cooperation in the stated subject areas.

Requirements for UK institution:

- The potential partner should be a UK-based university with academic strength in life science or pharmaceutical engineering.
- The potential partner should be willing to cooperate and to invest in long-term partnership
