Brief introduction of UIC

United International College (UIC) is situated in Zhuhai, Guangdong province China. The college is jointly founded by Beijing Normal University and Hong Kong Baptist University in 2005 and has quickly grown into an international institution with innovative educational approaches with a global vision since its first enrollment.

UIC maintains more than 75% of the academy staff from overseas and it is using English as the only medium of instruction. UIC's charter has been approved by the Ministry of Education and enrolls high quality students from 20 provinces. UIC currently has a total student number of 4,400 by the end of 2013.

Ambition from the Chinese partner

The program will be designed to use a "2+2" or similar education model, where students will spend two years studying at UIC first before going abroad for another two years in the UK. The target students of this program will be high school students who are interested in study abroad. The students may not necessarily have taken the Gaokao (National university entrance exam).
