'UK Week' was hosted at the British Council premises from 28th of July to the 1st of August. It was successful in attracting a good number of participants in its inaugural year. The program was held at the British Council premises and during the course of the week we had 220 students participating in the various activities.



Objective & Activities

'UK Week' was organised with the objective of building awareness among Nepalese students about the UK's education system, its culture and its society.

There was a vibrant atmosphere throughout the week with students thronging to receive counselling, attending screenings of blockbuster movies and participating in interactive UK related quizzes. One of the main attractions of the week was the presentations by UK universities. Further value was driven by providing attendees with an IELTS tip session and by running a Q&A program with Nepalese graduates from UK universities.
