

# Post-event report for

Study in the UK Exhibition 2015, Qatar

16-17 March 2015 Radisson Blu Hotel Doha

#### Introduction

The Study in the UK Exhibition was held on 16<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> March 2015. It offered an opportunity for students, parents, teachers and others in the education field to meet **representatives of 36 UK universities**, **Accredited English Language Schools and a selection of local scholarship providers** in person to find out what the UK has to offer and available funding opportunities. The target audiences were primarily 16 to 21 year olds interested in higher education in the UK; professionals seeking to advance their careers; parents and key influencers. Entrance was free for all visitors. Visitors were able to register in advance through the Education UK dedicated registration website or on arrival at the exhibition. The exhibition was very well attended by both UK universities and local audiences, and many took selfies with our Instagram cut out and tweeted to @BritFestQA and @qaBritish.

18<sup>th</sup> March was an optional day dedicated to schools visits. A visit to Al-Wakra Independent Secondary School for boys, who organised their annual college and career fair, sponsored by Qatar Steel targeted secondary schools students aged between 16 and 18 years old. In addition to meeting potential students, the fair provided UK institutions with a platform to network with more than 15 major scholarship providers. Al-Wakra's school visit was followed by a visit to the College of the North Atlantic Qatar targeting diploma holders students interested in top-up degrees in the UK (2+2 and 3+1)

The exhibition attracted over **1,000 visitors** through a variety of marketing channels and activities, which complimented each others. We believe the key for the growth in visitors' number from last year (around 500 visitors in 2014) is mainly due to starting the promotion plan of the event early 2 months prior to the exhibition and ensuring effective communication with school counsellors who are considered important influencers.

Of the total visitor numbers 34% were female, 66% were male.




### **Expectations**

This event met my expectations




### Quality

#### Some Recommendations from exhibitors

- Including lunch as part of the exhibition package
- Shifting the evening session starting time half an hour later as it seemed to be quitter in the first half an hour and much busier towards the end of the session
- To consider visits to girls schools
- Arrange more school visits and make them short and brief
- The event needs to be close to other BC events in The Gulf to make it worthwhile to attend
- More focus on the expat market is required

There are several areas that both British Council and the UK institutions can work on to improve the overall arrangement and outcomes of the exhibition. The main findings from the exhibitors' and the visitors' survey results and recommended next steps are outlined below:

### **British Council**

- We will consider working on a regional exhibitions plan to have the Gulf events close to each
  other
- We will consider arranging short visits to more schools instead of a long visit to one school
- We will also consider scheduling a longer networking session with school counsellors of both local and international schools
- We will try to have a booth for the UKVI to give students more information about the student visa requirements and process

#### **UK Institutions**

- It has been requested to give basic guidelines on the British system of study and the general expectations from universities in the UK to non-British curriculum school students.
- It has been also requested that institutions provide more information about the scholarship options for self-funded students including the expatriates in Qatar.
- It is suggested that institutions invite their alumni to attend future exhibitions and share experience of their life in UK with the visitors.
- It has been recommended for universities expecting a large number of enquiries to have 2 people at the booth to shorten the student waiting time at the stand.

Next year's exhibition (Currently Scheduled for March 2016) will build upon the lessons learned. We hope to see you there!
