



Partnership Opportunities in China

June 2012

Objectives:

- To identify partnership opportunities in China for UK institutions for international collaboration
- To facilitate partnership building in China for UK institutions under SIEM services

Background information:

There are currently over a hundred China-UK joint programmes approved by the Ministry of Education, accounting for 20% of the total approved joint programmes in China. In addition to these programmes, educational institutions in China and the UK have forged partnerships in many other ways such as faculty and student exchanges, articulation arrangements, research collaboration and teacher training. It is estimated that each year, through the transnational education partnerships, over 10,000 Chinese students choose the UK as their first choice for overseas study destination.

Working in China with a good partner is highly encouraged by the Chinese government. The UK's Secretary of State in Education, Michael Gove and China's Minister of Education Minister Yuan Guiren signed the UK-China Partners in Education at the 2011 UK-China Education Summit, encouraging more high quality China-UK partnership programmes. The National Mid to Long Term Education Reform and Development Programme (2010 to 2020) envisages attracting high quality overseas education resources to create partnership programmes. In the pursuit of partnerships between China and UK, quality instead of quantity is the top priority of the Chinese government as well as the educational institutions.
