



The visitors or visitors' child were **mainly from senior secondary school** –








Visitors' preferences

No. of visitors: n = 148 survey responses






While business is still the number one subject area of choice, the gap appears to have significantly narrowed to Medicine related subjects, with other areas in law, social studies and humanities showing an increase in enquiries.

Methodology

We distributed printed survey to the visitors during the exhibition and the visitors could get a souvenir after completing the survey. The questions were designed to gather quantitative statistics as well as qualitative remarks on visitors reactions to our exhibition and the decision making process.

83% of the visitors considering to study abroad within 1 year



Suggestions from visitors

Requested seminar topics

- Subject specific seminars, e.g. Art, aviation, biomedicine, law, neuroscience, occupational therapy, sport science
- How to apply HK University from UK high school
- How to write an attractive personal statement
- Student visa application procedure
- How to prepare for University life
- Statistics of different programmes

Key recommendations from visitors

- Lining up arrangements could be improved
- Hold more seminars
- Larger area for booth
- Better crowd control, don't clash with book fair

- Overall, a very good event but a bit expensive. Staff as usual was super helpful & polite, Keep the good work!
- Renaissance is a very good venue choice


Main complaints (responses following page)

- The board behind each booth makes the venue less spacious and it blocked the light, certain area in the middle of the conference room looked dark. So prefer not having them.
- This VRS system is not user friendly and not prefer like leaving the phone on the desk. It is recommend using the USA UG NACAC fair system of VRS & give delegates barcode scanners to use at the stand.

Future steps

There are several areas that both British Council and the UK institutions can work on to improve the overall arrangement and outcomes of the exhibition. The main findings and recommended next steps are outlined below:

British Council

- It is not easy to find an exhibition venue in Hong Kong which is big and at the central location. We tried to book the government owned exhibition venue in Causeway Bay again this year, but unfortunately it has been rejected. We will review the floor layout if we use Renaissance Harobourview Hotel again next year.
- We will re-design the booth layout and remove the back panel to free up more space in the exhibition venue.

UK institutions

- Institutions are encouraged to book the exhibition places as soon as it's launched (the exhibition was fully booked 2 days after the exhibition opened for recruitment last year), there would be tough competition due to the overwhelming responses from the institutions.
- Since most of the visitors were looking for undergraduate or pre-university programmes, so for schools and further education colleges, promoting 1-year A-level course or foundation would be more effective than 2 years A-level / IB programmes and vocation route in Hong Kong.
