

# TURKEY SCHOOL VISITS AND UK HIGHER EDUCATION DAYS

Wednesday, 14 November 2012

**This is a great opportunity for UK Universities to meet with students and their counsellors/advisors from prestigious private high schools and a university in Turkey!**

Aiming to promote UK undergraduate and postgraduate programmes, British Council Turkey will organize visits to 2 schools and a university for UK Universities. This exciting programme will consist of only 1 day visits in Istanbul on 14 November, Wednesday 2012. The format of the visits will involve mini-fairs and short briefing & presentation sessions.

**The School Visits and UK HE Days will include:**

- UK representatives to meet with school counsellors and international office representatives of the host institutions to receive a briefing about the profile of their institutions and students
- briefing from volunteer UK Institutions to talk about UK undergraduate study at the host high schools and postgraduate study at the host university covering information on
  - studying in the UK
  - applying to UK Universities (UCAS and application process)
  - personal statement
  - tips to consider for application
  - accommodation

*Depending on the availability of the schools and universities, briefing & presentation sessions and their times may vary from institutions to institutions lasting 20 to 30 minutes. Participants are welcome to select one or more of the topics above to cover during the sessions when they register online.*

<b>Date and City</b>	14 November 2012 Istanbul 2 schools + 1 university  <i>Each visit will last 1.5 hours maximum at schools and the timing at university will be longer; around 2 hours.</i>						
<b>Cost</b>	A fee of £450 + VAT will be charged to cover British Council costs under the British Council Services for International Education Marketing model.  <b>The participation fee will only include programme planning, co-ordination, logistic arrangements in cities and lunch during the visits. International or domestic flights, accommodation and subsistence should be covered by participants.</b>						
<b>Maximum participants</b>	20 – only one UK representative from each institution. For an additional place, please contact us. <b>Participant institutions can not be represented by their local agent.</b>						
<b>Cancellation deadlines</b>	The client may cancel the services prior to their delivery by giving the British Council written notice of cancellation. If the client cancels at least three weeks before <b>24 October 2012</b> the client shall not be required to pay the British Council any fees in connection with the cancelled Services and any fees already paid in respect of such cancelled Services shall be refunded by the British Council.
