


# Student's information

There were 74 and 50 visitors to the events in Hanoi and HCMC respectively


Majority of visitors were students and young professionals:



# **Exhibitor's feedback**


#### Main comments & recommendations for future event:

#### What is exhibitor's assessment of visitor's number?




#### What is exhibitor's assessment of visitor's quality?



# **Future steps for British Council**
