Call for Proposals

UK-based, 2 week Academic English-language course for a group of 15

young Peruvian students (13-19 years old | B2)

A client of the British Council in Peru is looking for a 2 week British Council Accredited

language course provider in the UK, to provide 20 hours of English language teaching per

week for a group of young English language students from Peru. Preferably, the school will

be city-based, and the course should be a combination of classes in the morning, a range of

sporting and cultural activities in the afternoons, with cultural excursions on the weekends.

Ideally the course should be Academic English, that could strengthen the courses they are

currently taking at school (Cambridge Curriculum) oriented to a foundation year. Classes

should be integrated with students from other countries to promote intercultural relations and

the use of the English Language, as long as it meets the students English language

requirements:

Duration: 2 weeks

Course Dates: Between 15 July and 15 August 2019

Group Description:

A group of 15 young Peruvian students, with an upper intermediate level of

English (B2), wishing to strengthen their Academic English skills (age range: 13-

19).

1 accompanying adult.

Accommodation:

The British Council Peru would like costing with regards to accommodation in homestay or

residence. The Language School will arrange accommodation according to the details

below:

1. For 15 junior students in homestay or residence. Staff of Language School will be

responsible for overnight supervision of students if at residence.

2. Quote for accommodation for 1 accompanying group leader, including

transportation from/to London if institution is located in a different city.

3. Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner for all students and group leader.

Cultural Activities:

These are additional components of the course which will enable students to learn more about the country, its people and culture. If the quote includes proposals for additional cultural activities, the latter should be planned ahead of time and have a learning objective, preferably linked to what students are learning in the classroom. A detailed programme of activities and Institution Activity Leaders assigned will be requested if selected.

The students would like the course to include visits and activities such as:

- Visits to universities with a technology focus, and hopefully sit in on a class
- Cultural tours to other cities on the weekends
- Plays or musicals in theatres, visits to football stadiums, castles, House of Shakespeare, Big Ben and Amusement parks etc.
- Attend a football or rugby game at a stadium

Proposal Terms of Reference:

- Justification;
- General and specific objectives of course;
- Teaching methodology and course content;
- Additional components and/or features to the programme (e.g. use of new technologies to support the learning of English; range of sporting/cultural activities available);
- Assessment System (including final student report);
- Materials to be used:
- Initial and final placement test;
- Certification;
- Proposed breakdown of costs/budget;
- Child Protection Policies in place within the institution
- Any other additional activities/services as a plus from the language school;
- Desirable: Variation of activities in different locations on or off-campus;
- Contact details of dedicated person assigned to British Council group.

The breakdown of costs/ budget should include:

- Tuition (course fees);
- Inclusion of group leaders' costs;
- Airport transfers from Heathrow Airport;

- Local transport if necessary;
- Accommodation;
- Meals (Breakfast, hot lunch, dinner);
- Placement test on arrival and departure using the same testing system;
- Course materials for each student;
- Final report of students' progress and certificates;
- Costs of cultural/other activities (entrance fees/hire of equipment etc.), excursions;
- International health and travel insurance.

ACTION REQUIRED

Proposals will be assessed according to compliance with the terms of reference above and breakdown of costs/budget. Only institutions shortlisted for consideration will be contacted for follow-up. Once a winning bid is confirmed we will announce the results through Newswire.
