STATISTICS: MEASURING THE UNOBSERVABLE

Introduction to latent variables and factor analysis using Mplus

Often the type of information in which we are most interested in education are the things that we cannot observe directly, such as student motivations, aptitude or ability. Factor analysis is commonly used to analyse such data. This workshop introduces participants to exploratory and confirmatory factor analysis (EFA and CFA) including both theory and hands-on practice.
