3. Possible meetings between the faculty/administrative staff from the University of Delhi and representatives from other departments of the host institution and external stakeholders to explore future collaboration or partnerships.
4. Tentative window of 10 days (in this financial year between January to March 2024) during which the workshop can be delivered.
