Report – Study UK open day in Delhi and NCR North India

Introduction: British Council organised a STUDY UK Open Day to the city of New Delhi/NCR from 5-9 August 2024. It was a one-week tour of schools where 38 UK universities met over 2000 students across 10 schools in Delhi and NCR (Gurgaon and Noida).

We received an overwhelming response from UK HEPs with 42 expressions of interest to participate in the UK Open Day. Spaces for the programme were offered on a first-come, first-served basis (based upon EOIs received).






Summary:


3. What is your assessment of the students at the Study UK open day?
