

TNE Opportunity in China

- Guangdong Pharmaceutical University (GDPU) calls for UK partner institutions to establish a joint programme in South China

Project Introduction

Guangdong Pharmaceutical University is very keen to establish undergraduate joint programs with the UK in subjects of pharmacy including nursing, public health, pharmaceutical information management and system, and pharmaceutical processing. The business model can be 2+2, 3+1, 3+1+1 or 4+1 and students can get degrees of both universities respectively.

Background of GDPU:

GDPU is one of the three pharmaceutical universities in China. It consists of 16 schools and departments such as school of pharmacy, school of public health, school of traditional Chinese medicine, school of clinical medicine, school of life science and bio pharmacology, etc. There are currently over 22000 students on campus.

The international college of GDPU is active in international exchange and cooperation and has set up the below partnership programs:

- Sino-Italy 4+2 program - The program is developed between GDPU and University of Calabria and the subjects cover pharmacy, bio-pharmacy, business management, and chemical engineering. Tuition and accommodation in Italy is free.
- Sino-UK 3+1 and 4+1 programs - The programs are developed between GDPU and university of Northampton. Subjects cover business management, international trade, international finance, and tourism management.
- Sino-US 3+1 program - The program is developed with Ohio Northern University, Madonna University and the University of Toledo. The subjects cover pharmacy, medical chemistry, pharmaceutical engineering, business management, marketing, and medical management.

Requirements for UK institution:

- Leading UK institutions with good reputation either in overall profile or in certain business related subjects
- The UK institutions should be willing and ready to follow the investment requirement set by the Ministry of Education, China (e.g. teaching resources, curriculum setting). They also hope the partner university can provide scholarships to their students who apply for the TNE programs.
