## Looking for British partner universities – Aoyama Gakuin University in Tokyo

Aoyama Gakuin University is currently looking for British partner universities for student exchanges, lasting for one or two academic semesters. This is due to expanding demand from our students to study in the UK. Our student exchange scheme for incoming students provides six level Japanese language courses, and faculty-advisor and student-buddy systems to help incoming international students. Incoming exchange students can also take regular academic courses, among which 30 – 40 courses are taught in English every semester. Incoming exchange students must meet the following conditions:

- A minimum score of N5 in the JLPT or an equivalent level of Japanese proficiency
- Academic standings equivalent to a lower-second or above

Aoyama Gakuin, which was founded by missionaries from the Methodist Episcopal Church, marks its 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2014. The University, the largest institute in Aoyama Gakuin, has two campuses with a total enrolment of around 20,000 students.
