# Structured Systems Methodology (SSM)



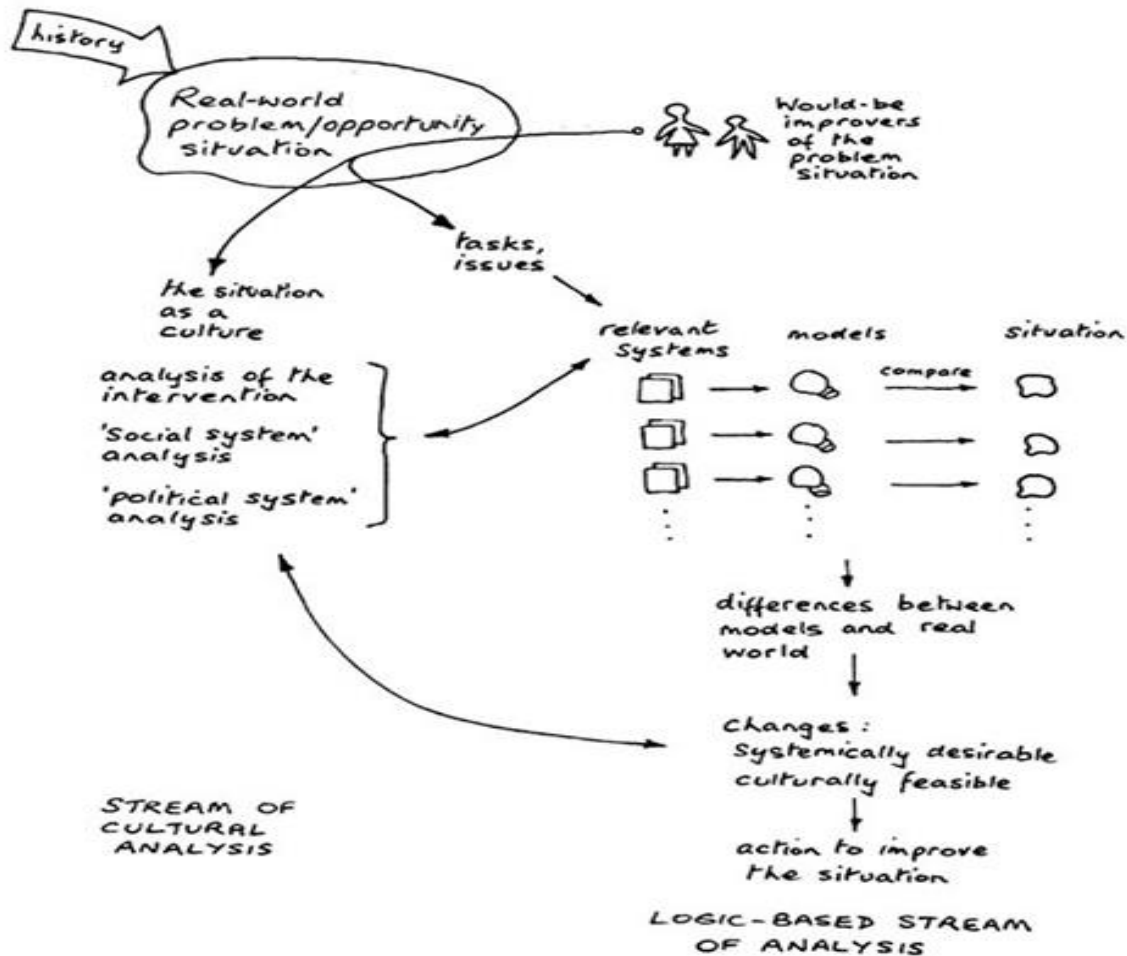
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Taking changing worldviews and embedding them into purposeful action

Changing from a “very soft problem” to a “less softer problem”

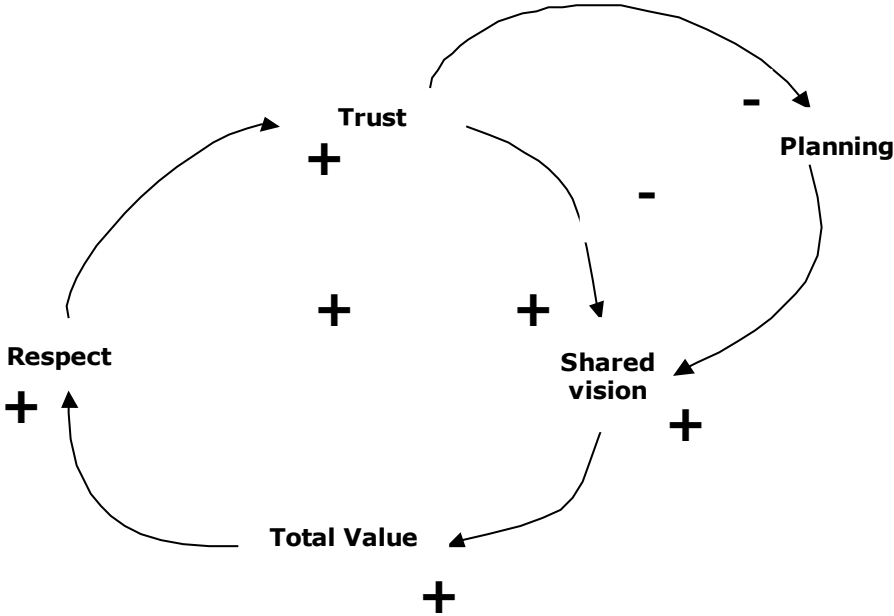
SSM uses System Thinking

# Systems Thinking



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It is very difficult to divide the whole into independent parts

One cannot improve the whole by improving individual parts

Everything is dependent on everything else

The whole is always better than the sum of the parts

- Reactive not proactive



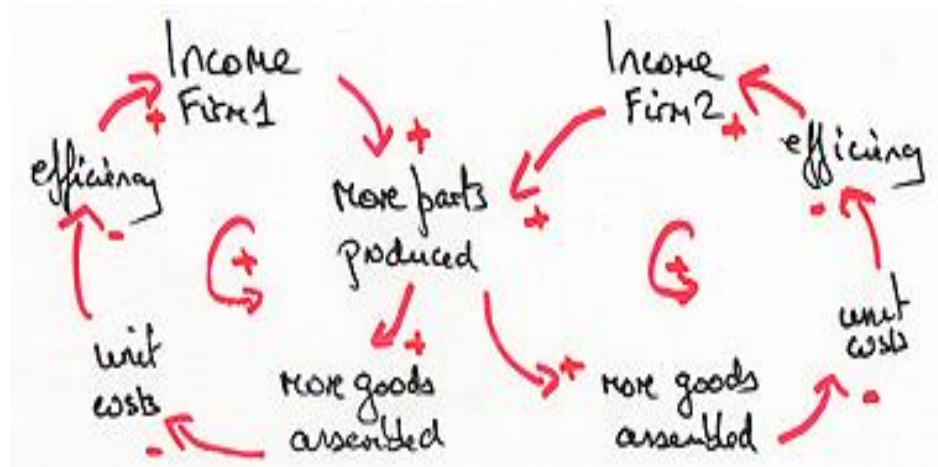
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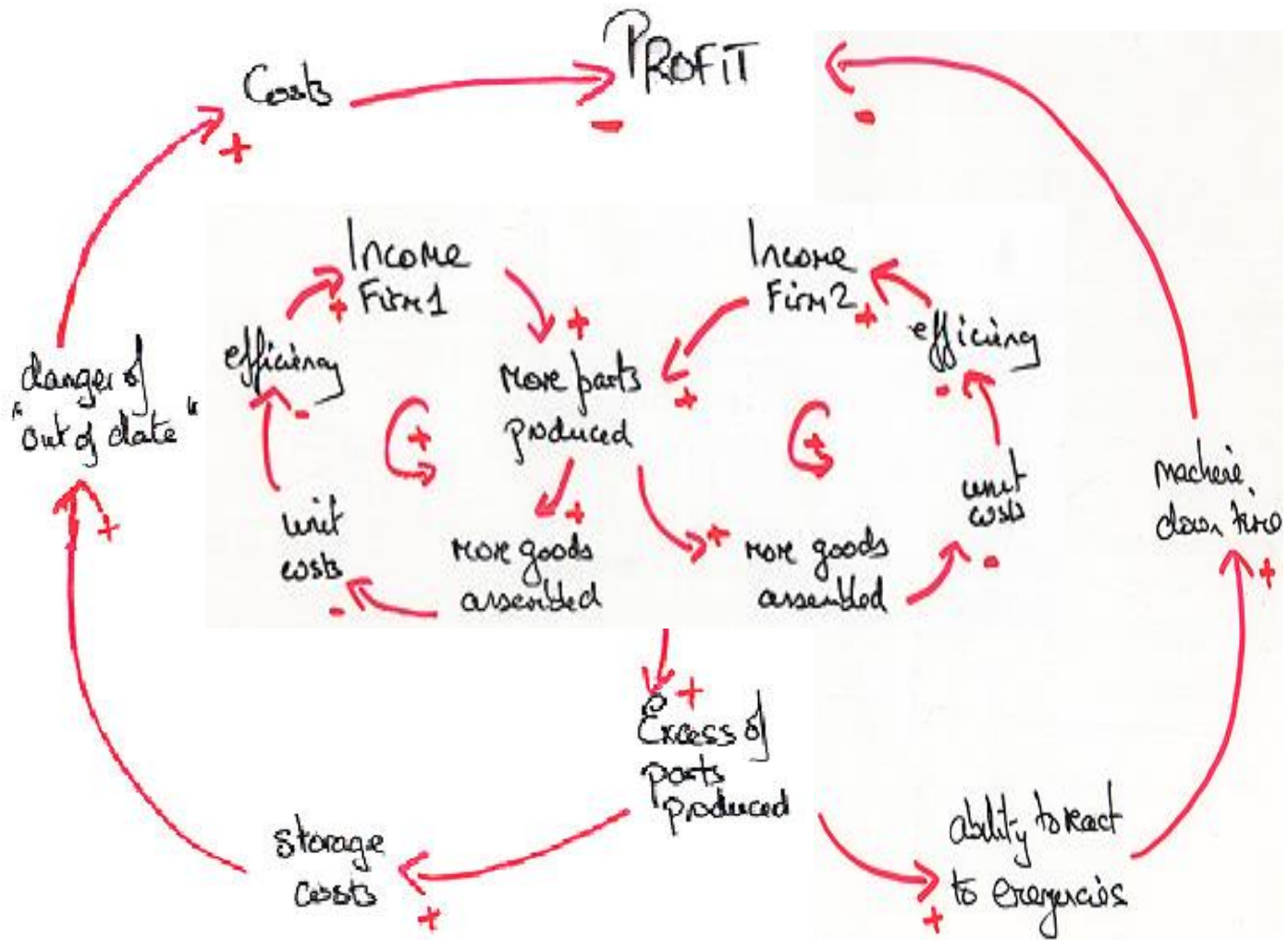
