
Total Population in 2019: **73,212,100** people

Kazakhstan's Economy in 2019



Real GDP rate 4.4% YoY (October 2019)



2% Oil production increase (October 2019)



Real export rate growth (non-oil products)



2.6% Industrial growth (down same period 2018)



4.8% Unemployment rate (June 2019)

- New Minister of Education in Kazakhstan and a new education strategy is to be developed
- ➤ Launch of "Zhas Maman" Programme
- > Transition to 12-year education by 2021
- Kazakhstan among Top 10 sending countries
- Bolashak Scheme Changes and Updates
- > Transition to Latin Alphabet
- ➤ Education Spending increase in the next few years
- Kazakh HEIs open up summer courses
- > Slowly introducing trilingual education

State of the art equipment





- Kazakhstan education spending increased by 21.5% compared to last year
- 338.5 bln tenge ≈ £677 mln
- The government plans to increase education costs up to 5% of GDP in the next few years


Quick Analysis of "Bolashak" Students

Most popular subject areas:




