Chongqing University of Posts and Telecommunications (CQUPT) is looking for UK partners to develop partnership programmes (Bachelor and Master courses) in Data Science and Big Data Technology, Financial Mathematics, Artificial Intelligence, and Supply Chain Management, etc., with the goal of recruiting up to 100 students per year for each programme.

Form of cooperation

- Articulation programme at BA or MA level
- Bachelor's joint programme in the form of 4+0 or 3+1
- Master's joint programme in the form of 3+0 or 1+1+1
- · Joint-institute school without independent legal entity

Benefits for the UK partners

This provides an opportunity for the UK universities to:

- establish long-term partnership with CQUPT, potential for expansion into other fields such as research, articulation, student exchange, faculty exchange, teacher training, joint research etc.
- attract more domestic and international students.
- enhance recognition and reputation in China, especially in Southwest China.
- · establish alumni association and social network in China.
- benefit from local industrial and economic outcomes with locally based companies in information and telecommunications industry.

Areas of responsibility for the two collaborating parties

The UK partner university will be expected to work with CQUPT to:

- co-develop the curricula for the joint programmes with CQUPT, undertaking at least 1/3 of core courses and 1/3 of all courses, undertaking at least 1/3 of the teaching hours
- provide qualified teaching staff for the joint programme, and be able to deliver in-person courses for the joint programmes by deploying teachers to China
- provide support in the quality assurance of the programmes
- award bachelor/master's degree to students

CQUPT will be responsible for:

- promoting and recruiting students for the programmes
- providing qualified teaching staff as well as the required teaching premises and facilities for the joint programmes
- award bachelor/master's degree to students
