

Chongqing College of Electronic Engineering seeks UK partners for HE partnership programmes

Opportunity

Chongqing College of Electronic Engineering (CQCEE) is looking forward to working with a UK partner to establish partnership programme.

The format of collaboration could be 3+0 or 2+1 for dual diplomas, in form of articulation programme, joint programme or joint institute without legal person entity, and in fields of Information Security, Internet of Things Applications and Automobile Manufacturing or other possible fields. CQCEE expects to recruit up to 180 students (3 to 4 classes) annually to the programme.

Benefits for the UK partners

It is a great opportunity for the selected UK partner to establish long-term partnerships with CQCEE which has extensive experience in corporate-institute collaboration and sharing international collaboration resource. In addition, CQCEE is flexible to work with UK partners to develop potential exchange programmes, such as faculty exchange, hosting international academic conference or seminars, international vocational skills competitions.

Areas of responsibility for the UK partner

The selected UK partner will be expected to:

- be a further education institute or TVET college in the UK
- be able to work with CQCEE to comply with the local government approval process of the programmes
- be able to develop joint programmes with CQCEE in Chongqing, China, undertaking at least 1/3
 of core courses and 1/3 of all courses, undertaking at least 1/3 of the teaching hours
- work with CQCEE to co-develop the curricula for the joint programmes
- provide support in the quality assurance of the programmes
- issue diplomas to students who meet the graduation requirements of both parties
- be able to deliver face-to-face courses to students either by deploying teachers to China or by accommodating international students from China
- expand other relevant potential collaborations.

About Chinese Partner

Chongqing College of Electronic Engineering (CQCEE) is a full-time higher education institution that was founded by the Chongqing Government in 1965. It is administered by Chongqing Education Commission and co-constructed by Chongqing Economy and Information Commission. CQCEE is located in Chongqing (the only municipality in Southwest China).
