I was really surprised and pleased to receive a phone call a few weeks later letting me know that I had won a prize!"

For now, Abdul Aziz is continuing with his studies in Sylhet but hopes to study in the UK at some point in the future. "I'm concentrating on improving my English speaking skills and then I will take my IELTS exam. Then I hope to be able to apply for further study at a UK university."
