Terms and Conditions of the contract

Introduction and Background

The British Council is seeking a supplier to conduct research into Romania-UK Transnational Education (TNE)

The furthering of collaboration between Romania and UK in higher education with a special focus on Transnational Education (TNE) is a major priority of the British Council in Romania. TNE here refers to UK university programmes offered in Romania in conjunction with Romanian partners. Existing partnerships are visible at https://www.britishcouncil.ro/en/study-uk/uk-qualification

In order to further develop our work in this area following interruption of initiatives by the pandemic we require an in-depth understanding of:

- **2.1.1 the current market context**. This should address questions such as:
 - What is understood in Romania by 'Transnational Education'?
 - How are UK universities perceived as partners post-Brexit?
 - How are existing UK-Romania TNE partnerships faring and what may be in the pipeline?
 - Which models of collaboration are or aren't working?
- **2.1.2** how the regulatory situation in Romania helps and hinders collaboration. This should address questions such as:
 - What is the current legal context and recognition process for transnational degrees?
 - What is the likely impact of any planned or proposed legislation?
 - How does Quality Assurance work in TNE partnerships?
 - What is the validity of TNE qualifications in Romania?
- **2.1.3** where there is opportunity for new partnerships. This should address questions such as:
 - Which (type of) institutions are most interested?
 - What is the relative demand from public and private institutions?
 - What types of collaboration are most sought after?
 - Where are the main gaps which academic subjects / types of courses?

2.1.4 what the main challenges and obstacles in developing Romanian-UK TNE partnerships are.

This should address questions on the relative importance of potential barriers, such as:

- Pricing of programmes;
- Awareness of existing and potential opportunities;
- English language skills;
- Regulation;

2.1.5 how can the British Council add value and provide support to institutions? This should address questions such as the value of:

- Facilitating online connections between institutions;
- Facilitating face to face connections between institutions;
- Raising awareness of TNE opportunities to students;
- Lobbying;

We will **share research undertaken in 2020** with interested parties. This research requires updating and a greater strategic focus.

2.2 The role

British Council in Romania would like to request a quotation from a researcher (individual consultant) or a research company for undertaking in-depth research as per the Introduction and Background above.

The successful supplier will deliver the following deliverables between January and March 2023:

- a detailed Research Report
- an executive summary
- a PowerPoint presentation
- and be ready to participate in a webinar/s with UK universities.

Job description:

The researcher will gather data, analyse the data and highlight the findings and write a Research Report. The researcher needs quantitative and qualitative skills, knowledge of data analysis tools and proficiency in statistical applications.

Qualifications and experience required

- Post-graduate qualification in relevant field (such as sociology, sciences of education, humanities)
- Proven research experience
- Excellent investigative skills
- Proven expertise in data collection methods, data analysis tools and statistical applications
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Excellent presentation skills and ability to write research reports for publication in English
- Knowledge of the higher education landscape in Romania and the ability to conduct interviews in Romanian language are essential, and knowledge of the UK HE landscape is highly desirable
