




Student ID	Visiting Student will receive a KU Student ID within (1) month of the semester start.

Course Load Credits/semester	Home institution determines course load for visiting student. Regular course load for undergraduate student is 15-18 credits/semester; however, the maximum cannot exceed 21 credits. As for graduate program course load is 9-15 credits/semester.

Transcript	Partner Exchange Offices will receive CBA official transcript of visiting student within (1) month of the semester end.			
Visa Procedures & Required Documents	 Student should provide a copy of passport (validity ≥ 3 years) and flight details. The original visa will be kept with KU representative who is in responsible of the student's reception at Kuwait International Airport, noted that the visa is valid for (3) months. Student must get a Kuwaiti Residency if study period >3 months period according to the student's law of residence in Kuwait. Student is not allowed to travel anywhere before getting the Kuwait residency. 			
Health Insurance	Visiting Student should contact Kuwait Embassy branch in the country to know the requirements and procedures of health insurance.			
Arrival Date.	Student may arrive <u>not earlier than (1) day prior to the Orientation Program</u> for Incoming Student (Wednesday & Thursday).			
Transportation	 Free Airport pick-up and drop-in is available by Kuwait University. KU Representative name and contact information are provided to Partner Institution and Visiting Student (1) week before arrival time by email. Acknowledgement of Student's arrival date is required to provide free pick-up from Kuwait International Airport. Student may have to pick up an airport taxi for drop in KU Students Housing in case of any change occurs in the flight schedule.
