- Observing the real Art and Music classes in a local secondary schools
- Introduction and practice STEA(Art)M programme which relates to Arts
  - Field Trips to the following places are highly preferred: National Gallery, Royal Academy of Art, Tate Modern Gallery, Queen Elizabeth Hall(London Symphony Orchestra), Babican Centre, etc: Highly reputable places
