

Description of 'Destination: UK Boarding Schools & Sixth Form Colleges' campaign activities

UK Boarding School Head Teacher Mission

Description	The UK Boarding School Head Teachers Mission to China is a large scale outward mission under the UK government's GREAT campaign. It aims to showcase the benefits of a UK boarding school education to local affluent families, and create platforms to explore opportunities for cooperation with education authorities, education agents, local schools, and mainstream media outlets.
	During the 2014 mission, the visiting head teachers met with more than 150 local head teachers, more than 250 education agents, and more than 50 journalists, in addition to hundreds of parents.
	In 2015, ten UK boarding school head teachers will visit the cities of Beijing, Shanghai and Guangzhou to talk with students and their parents, network with agents, take media interviews, and speak at education exhibitions.

UK Sixth Form College Mission

Description	The UK Sixth Form College Mission to China aims to showcase the benefits of a UK sixth form college education to local middle-class families, and create platforms to explore opportunities for cooperation with education authorities, education agents, local schools, and mainstream media outlets. In 2015, ten sixth form college delegates will visit the cities of Chengdu, Xi'an and Changsha to talk with students and their parents, and network with agents.
Objectives	 To raise the profile of the UK sixth-form colleges sector in China To raise awareness of your college's brand and educational offering in the Chinese market To establish partnerships with education agents in China To enlarge your potential student pool for the recruitment season

Description	The British Council will organise a UK tour for Chinese education agents, which will include visits to up to six schools, including boarding schools and sixth form colleges. An education fair will also be organised to allow agents to network with education providers.
