EMC Punjab & North: Package 3 Combined tour of both cities

A detailed itinerary which includes host schools and other participating schools will be shared with participating UK institutions after confirmation of participation from UK institutions is received.

Important Information:

- 1. **Cost of package 1: EMC Punjab only:** a participating fee of £850 +VAT per UK institution will be charged
- 2. Cost of package 2: EMC North only: a participating fee of £850 +VAT per UK institution will be charged
- 3. Cost of package 3: EMC Punjab & North: a participating fee of £1500+VAT per UK institution will be charged
- 4. Travel to local institutions within the city will be covered by the British Council
- 5. Participating delegates are required to fund their own international air travel, accommodation and related expenses. We shall recommend hotels for accommodation to participating delegates directly
- 6. EMC is open only to UK institutions/ local country offices and selection will be on first-come, firstserved basis
- 7. EMC will be open to a minimum of 6 UK institutions. Only one delegate per institution will be allowed to participate

Appendix:

Students from the chosen cities and schools have shown keen interest in pursuing UK education. They welcome UK institutions to visit, interact and advise students on opportunities for higher education in the UK. The <u>last EMC Punjab</u> was held in September 2013 with a delegation from 12 UK institutions. They visited 6 schools in 4 cities in Punjab: Sialkot, Faisalabad, Multan and Bahawalpur. It received encouraging feedback and resulted in the launching of EMC North as well.
