Faculty Exchange Programme – Teaching opportunity in Pakistan

British Council Pakistan partnered with Sindh Madressatul Islam University (SMIU) in 2014 and has jointly organised several programmes with them in the UK and Pakistan. SMIU is looking to hire qualified/experienced teaching faculty from UK for teaching at SMIU for one semester (i.e. from August to December) in 2016 on contractual basis.

Profile - SMIU

Sindh Madressatul Islam University is one of the oldest educational institutions of Pakistan. It was established by Khan Bahadur Hassanally Effendi as a school in 1885, was upgraded to college in 1943 and elevated to university in 2012. One of the distinctions of the institution is that Founder of Pakistan, Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah, studied here for the longest period of his academic life from 1887 to 1892 and bequeathed one-third of his personal property to it through his last will. He also upgraded it from school to college on 21 June 1943.

Presently, it is a university duly recognised by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) and recently it has been awarded highest “W” category by the HEC for its quality assurance. SMIU is considered as one of the leading universities of the country imparting quality education in five disciplines i.e. Media Studies & Social Science, Computer Science, Business Administration, Environmental Science and Education. It has state of the art laboratories, library, Media Studios (TV and Radio studios) and other academic facilities with highly qualified faculty and administration.

In addition to its present historic city campus, the University is also in the process of building its additional campus in the Education City (near DHA city) in the vicinity of Karachi, where 100 acres of land have been allotted to SMIU and the first building there is about to be completed.
