





Future plans (what worked and what did not?):

There are several areas that both British Council and the UK institutions can work on to improve the overall arrangement and outcomes of the exhibition. The main findings and recommended next steps are outlined below:

British Council

 Going forward, British Council (Country) will better coordinate our schedule with the region and tie-in our own exhibition with other regional countries' events, to enable exhibitors to maximize their time and budget in a single trip.

UK Institutions

- It is suggested that institutions invite their alumni to attend future exhibitions and share tales of their life in UK with the visitors.
- Many visitors are looking for that scholarships opportunities, we recommend institutions to look at ways of providing some sort of scholarship or discount and highlight these during future exhibitions.
