Exhibitor's Feedback

When exhibitors were asked "Would you consider coming back to the next British Council event in Egypt?" 75% of survey takers said yes.

When exhibitors were asked "this event met my expectations" and "Overall, this was a high quality event" 75% of survey takers said yes.

Some feedback from exhibitors:

1) School visits:

These were generally good both in terms of quality of enquiries and their numbers. If I come again I would be happy visiting the same schools.

2) Alexandria Exhibition:

The numbers were amazing, and many of them were of a good quality, with a good mix of UG and PG queries. My stand was absolutely mobbed by tens of enquirers all the time. I also ran out of prospectuses too early. This is ultimately a 'nice problem to have' because it means the event was successful in terms of numbers.

Future plans (what worked and what did not?):

There are several areas that both British Council and the UK institutions can work on to improve the overall arrangement and outcomes of the exhibition. The main findings and recommended next steps are outlined below:

British Council

 Going forward, British Council (Country) will better coordinate our schedule with the region and tie-in our own exhibition with other regional countries' events, to enable exhibitors to maximize their time and budget in a single trip.

UK Institutions

- It is suggested that institutions invite their alumni to attend future exhibitions and share tales of their life in UK with the visitors.
- Many visitors are looking for that scholarships opportunities, we recommend institutions to look at ways of providing some sort of scholarship or discount and highlight these during future exhibitions.

Next Education UK Egypt fair will be held in Cairo and Alexandria on 28 and 29 April 2017. We hope to see you there!
