

CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM

Dantri- VN this morning 10/28, the Ministry of Education and Training and the Ministry of Labor, Invalids and Social Affairs signed a circular granting students the permission to further their education.

This document is applied for vocational secondary schools, vocational college. University and institutes. Therefore, students who want to further their education must have a certificate provided by the vocational school or college. Students who have just graduated from high school must have enough knowledge and finish a graduation. exam with soficient marks according to the rules from the Ministry of Education and Training.

The process of recruiting students for continuing education programs. for inter-college and inter-university will be done following the regulations from the Ministry of Education and training

The College and University, who are assigned to carry out the continuing education programs for inter-college and inter-university. must follow all the regulations issued by the Ministry of Education and Training. The contextum and the program for continuing education. have been completed based on the rules and the ortana of the Ministry of Education and Training.

The program for continuing education, which helps fulfill the. nsufficient knowledge and skills of the sludents without repeating. nformation that students have already learnt, must be established based on the framework set out by the Ministry of Education and Training to ensure that students are provided with sufficient. knowledge.

The duration for confinuing education from primary to intermediate. levels will be from one and a half to two years and from oblege to University will be from three to four years. Permission for creating the continuing education program must be approved by the Ministry of Education and Training.

Continuing education must be organized based on the regulations for training at universities and colleges issued by the Ministry of Education and Training.

Granting students with degrees after completing a continuing education program for inter-college and inter-university will be done. based on the regulations issued by the Ministry of Education and Training.



NATIONAL AND ASEAN 2012 SKILLS COMPETITION

National Skills Competition 2012 was organized to honor of the young highly skilled workforce, promote skills training to encourage the teachers and learners. This was an opportunity to recruit and improve the best candidates and after that established national team to attend the ASEAN Skills Competition in Indonesia 2012.

July 2012, Hanoi Vocational College of High Technology hosted successfully 07 out of 20 trades of Vietnam Skills Competitions 2012. All HHT students participating in the Competition won prizes. Including: 4 first prizes with 1 in Electronics, 2 in Industrial Automation and 1 in Network System Administration; 2 Second prizes in Mechatronics; and 3 Motivation prizes with 1 in Electronics, 1 in Web Design, 1 in Network System Administration.

Participated ASEAN Skills Competition 2012 in Indonesia, Hanoi Vocational College of High Technology had 04 candidates took part in 03 vocational: Electronics, IT network management and industrial automation. Students of HHT had won 2 Silver Prizes in Industrial Automation.

THE THIRD NATIONAL SELF-MAKING TEACHING EQUIPMENT COMPETITION IN 2010

The competition took place from the 18^{th} to the 23^{rd} of August 2010 at Hanoi Vocational College of High Technology, which is organized by MOLISA every 5 years to promote the creativity of lecturers in the skillsteaching units within the whole country.

The competition this year was large scale, gathering 35 provinces and cities of Vietnam with 237 equipments.

In this competition, the HHT Faculty of Electronics competed with the industrial electronics practicing model. The model won the First Prize of Industrial Electronics Subcommittee with a total score of 95,4/100 for its superior aesthetic, pedagogical, scientific, technical and feasible features.








STUDENTS' SINGING FESTIVAL 2010
