

Overview of the Bangladesh higher education market, schools examination boards and what the numbers mean for UK institutions

In the last year, over 1 million candidates took the Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) examination. This year the HSC (under the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Exams, Bangladesh Technical Education Board) examinations as well as Kamil exams started from 1 April 2015 which is the equivalent exam under Bangladesh Madrasah Education Board.

From 2013 to 2014 the number of candidates appearing for HSC and equivalent exams has increased by 12%. After the examination, students target to get enrolled in the undergraduate programmes offered by the Public Universities, Private Universities and colleges under National University and Bangladesh Open University.

In the last couple of years we have seen a constant growth in number of examinees graduating through Higher Secondary Certificate.

The result of this year's HSC and equivalent examinations came out on 9 August 2015. Total pass rate for HSC and equivalent examinations is 69.60%. A total of 10,61,614 students under 10 education boards, including madrasa and technical boards took part in the examination this year. Under General Education Board the pass rate is 65.84% where 876,476 students took part in the examination. 577,087 students passed in the examination and 34,721 students received Grade Point Average (GPA) 5 out 5.

Under Technical Education boards the pass rate is 85 % where total 98,296 students took part in the examination. 84,125 no of students passed in the examination and 6,430 of students received Grade Point Average (GPA) 5 out 5.

Under Madrasa Education Board the pass rate is 90.19% where total 82,558 students took part in the examination. 74,461 no of students passed in the examination and 1,435 of students received Grade Point Average (GPA) 5 out 5.







The HSC, Kamil and HSC under BTEB exams will be ending in the first week of June 2015.
