Introduction

Thank you very much for your participation in the International School Roadshow – Vietnam January 2016.

For the first year, the International School Roadshow took its tour to 9 international schools in Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi over 4 days from 12 - 15 January. This event had the participation of delegates from 13 UK universities who took this opportunity to meet prospective students, build up relationship and strengthen links with international schools in Vietnam.

The roadshow reached 890 students studying GCSE, A Levels, IB, bi-lingual programmes at 9 international schools. They had face-to-face counselling with representatives from UK universities and attended subject-focused seminars.

The roadshow also opened for engagement with more international schools, which did not have opportunity to host the roadshow this year, through a networking event organised in Ho Chi Minh City. Head of Schools and Career Guidance Counsellors from 9 international schools and bi-lingual schools came to the networking and had fruitful conversation with UK representatives.

This report is to provide you with brief summary of the event, including student information and exhibitor feedback. We trust that this report will enable you to report the return on investment benefits and assist with future decision making.

Finally, we highly appreciate your support, and look forward to working more closely with you in coming roadshow and a wide range of other educational promotion activities during the year.





There were close to **890 students** from **9 international schools in HCMC and Hanoi**. Here's the break down to number of students from each school:








(n = 521 survey responses collected from information sheet)




- Creates awareness and helps understand the market

- To extend the timings, have more time in each schools + travel


What is exhibitor's assessment of student NUMBER for schools?






What is exhibitor's assessment of student QUALITY for schools?


In terms of event management, how do exhibitors rate the quality of each activity below?

Future steps for British Council

- Event timing: Given that October is a good timing for international students having result and making decision, we will organise the next international school roadshow in October 2016. This event will also connect with the Education UK Exhibition which makes it more convenient for exhibitors in planning for their trips.
- Event communication: To improve communication about event arrangements, we will work with schools more closely to agree on programme two months in advance. This will speed up communication about logistic arrangements with exhibitors better.
- Working with more international schools: we will continue to work with schools that were rated good in this year's event, meanwhile extend partnership with other potential and better-targeting international schools, especially in HCMC, in the next event.
