The event

- All the roadshow's hosting schools invited their year 11 and 12 students to attend the fair at the scheduled time, making a blocked hour from teaching, this increased the number of students attending the fairs.
 - The schools also invited the parents.
- For the first time we visited Cairo American College, one of the best schools in Egypt, which does not hold fairs or visits from private companies into their campus
- At the third day, all universities were invited to attend the UK Alumni Awards in Egypt, a prestigious ceremony hosted by HMA to Egypt,
 Sir Geoffrey Adams at the British Embassy in Cairo.

Exhibitor's Feedback

When exhibitors were asked "to recommend the British Council events to your peers and colleagues?" 100% of survey takers said yes.

When exhibitors were asked "this event met my expectations" and "Overall, this was a high quality event" 100% of survey takers said yes and agreed.



British Council

UK Institutions
