

Post-event report for

Study UK exhibition 2018

27-28 January 2018 Hong Kong

Introduction

- The Study UK exhibition was held on 27 and 28 January, with 103 institutions exhibiting.
- During the two days on which the exhibition was held, over 4,800 visitors attended (compared to 5,100 visitors last year).
- A bomb from the Second World War was discovered on the afternoon of 27 January. A
 section of road in Wan Chai was cordoned off and this affected visitor numbers slightly. The
 discovery of the bomb also meant that 1,300 people had to be evacuated from nearby
 buildings.
- The event attracted media coverage. Most of the coverage highlighted the appetite for studying in the UK among Hong Kong students and the number of student visas issuances between Q1 and Q3.

Highlights





Visitor profile

The visitors were mainly senior secondary students or the parents of senior secondary students.




Over half of the visitors (or the visitors' children) attend a <u>local public school or a local private school</u> (including <u>Direct Subsidy Scheme schools</u>).



There was an increase in the percentage of visitors (or visitors' children) who were currently studying at an overseas boarding school compare with last year.






