

Call for UK Institutions to promote their scholarships to students in South Asia in 2015-16

British Council's Services for International Education Marketing (SIEM) in South Asia is creating an EducationUK Scholarship Booklet specifically for South Asian students. Scholarships are a key deciding factor for students in the region when looking at study overseas. This booklet will highlight the vast array of scholarships and bursaries on offer for students considering the UK and provide an easy search guide for both general UK scholarships and bursaries as well as departmental/University level scholarships and bursaries on offer to students from South Asia.

The booklet will list UG and PG Taught scholarships and bursaries for students across the following five countries in the region: Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. The booklet will also carry information on Government scholarships available in each country (Including Chevening, GREAT and others).

- Flyers and Posters communicating where the booklet is available as well as logos of all participating institutions will be printed and distributed to students and influencers at our events.
