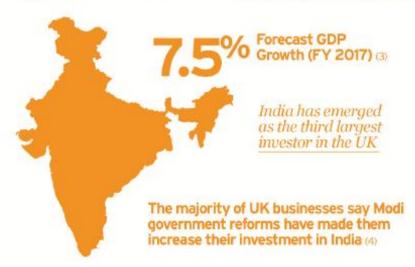
The UK is a world-leading nation of innovators, the UK has won 78 Nobel Prizes in natural and physical sciences and has the largest life sciences sector in Europe

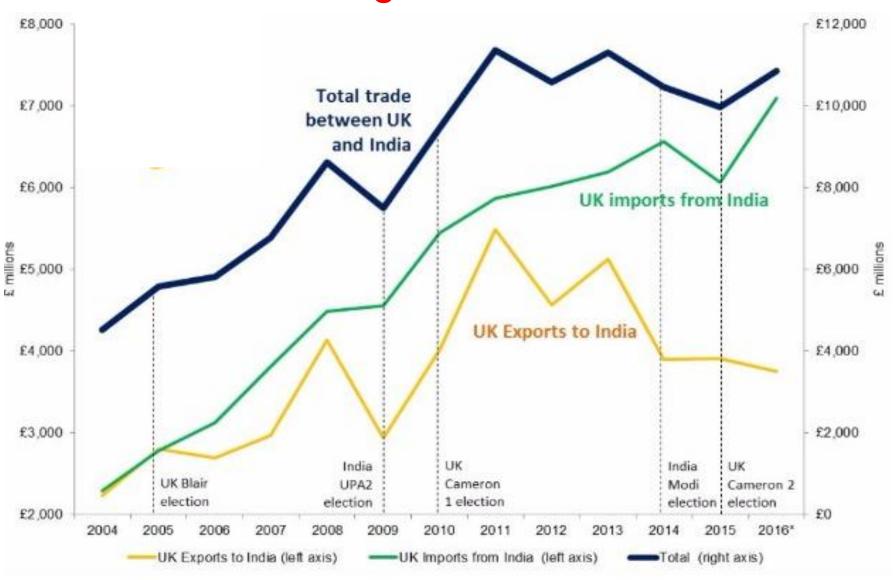

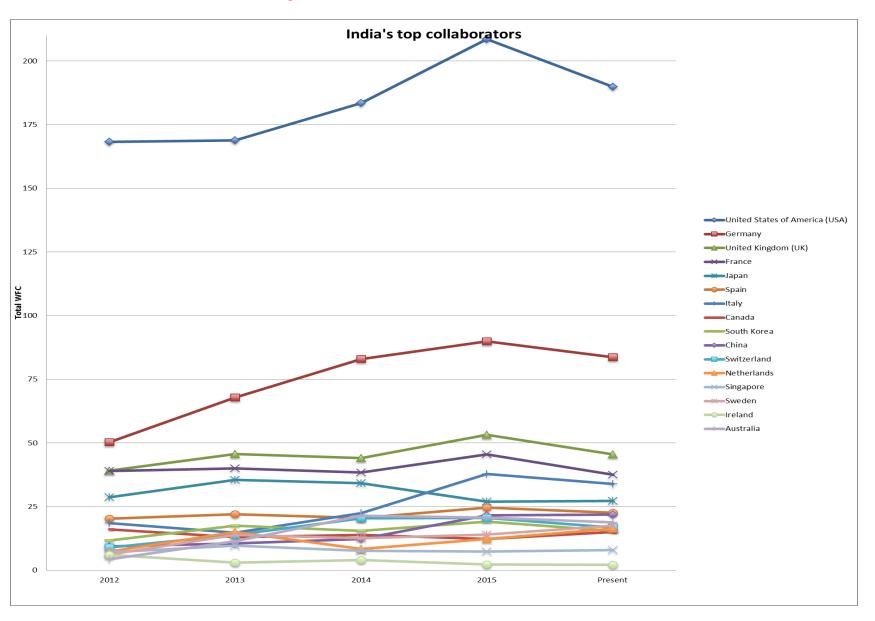

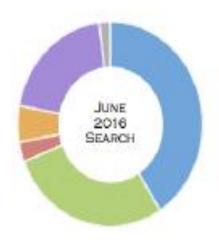
Overall: Focus on financial opportunity and positive and negative effects of the vote - and lesser concerns around racism and wider implications

Students: Long term concern about academic funding but with potential for cheaper fees

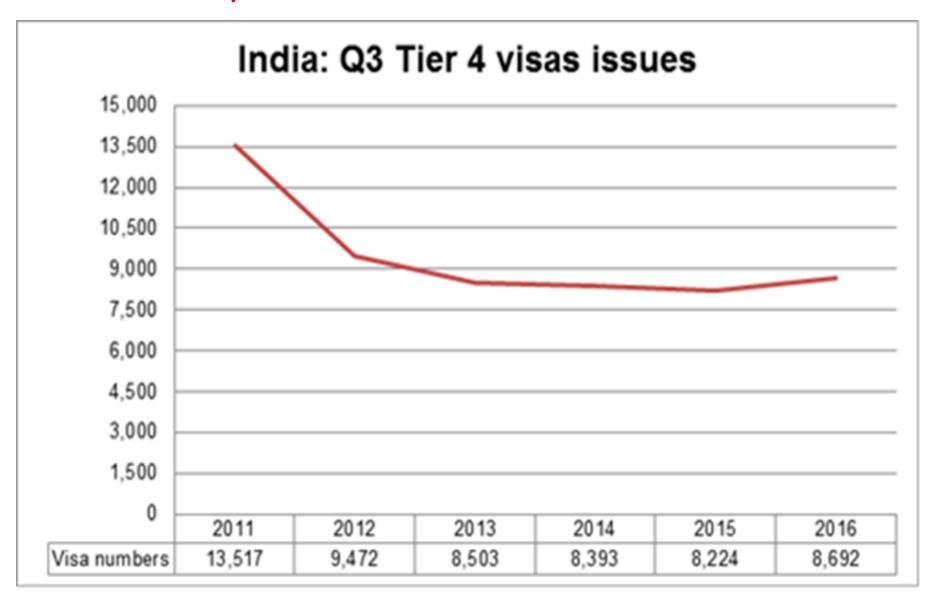
Tourism: Significant increase in search and discussion around value for money holidays in UK (139% increase, and 51% for hotels)

Work/Immigration: Longer term concerns about Indian companies, increased racism and the tech sector (140% increase in racism searches – dropped to 38% by July)

Where are they applying from?

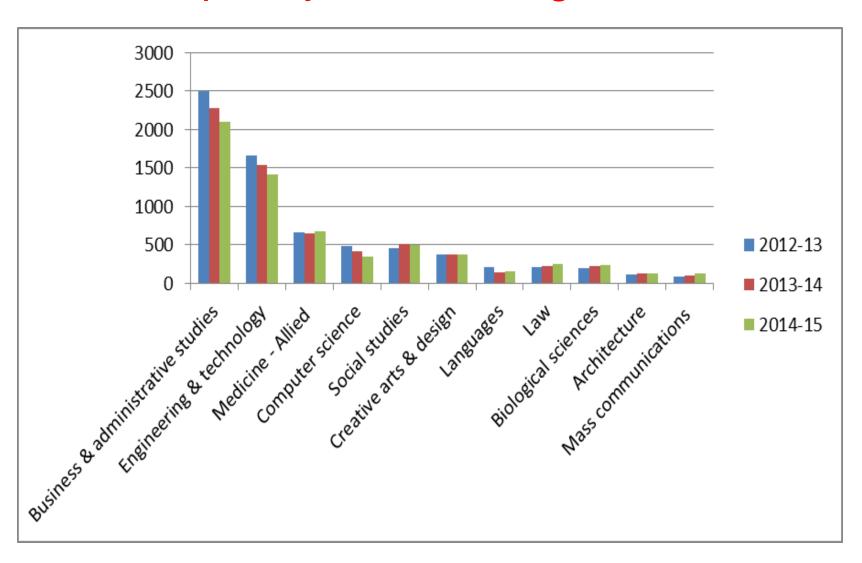
Tier 4 application VAC data indicates 8 key cities

Over 50% applications are from 2 metro cities (Delhi 29%, Mumbai 23%)

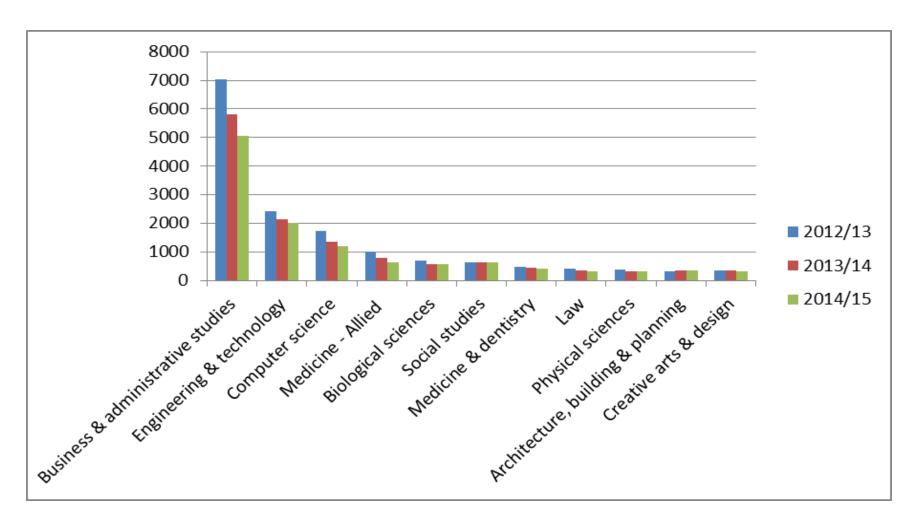
Mini metro markets include Bangalore, Chennai (10% of applications each)

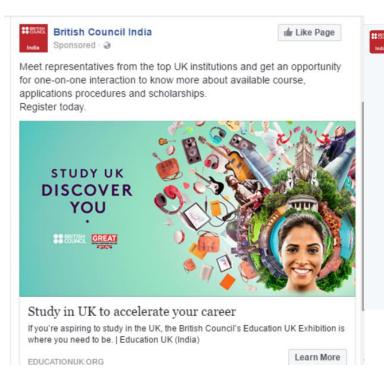
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
