Introduction

- The Study UK exhibition was held on January 21st and 22nd, with 104 institutions exhibiting
- During the two days over 5,100 visitors attended compared to 6,200 visitors last year.
- The event attracted extensive media coverage. It generated 26 pieces of coverage and the
 total advertising equivalent value is HK\$665,649. Most of the coverage highlighted the
 stories about the UK Alumnus Louisa Mak, Miss Hong Kong 2015 and the benefits of
 studying in the UK.






Visitors' profile

The visitors or visitors' children were mainly from senior secondary school -




Over half of them attend <u>local public school or local private school (including Direct Subsidy</u> Scheme school) in 2017:




More visitors or visitors' children were from local school compare with last year.

Majority were looking for undergraduate and boarding school in both 2016 and 2017 and there is a sharp increase of interest in boarding school in 2017.



While business is still the number one subject area of choice, the gap appears to have significantly narrowed to health & medicine, with other areas in Creative Arts and Design, Law and Humanities. Engineering and Computer Science were showing an increase in enquiries compare with last year.






