- The Study UK Fair was held on 23 and 24 February, with 85 institutions exhibiting.
- During the two days on which the exhibition was held, over 6,300 visitors attended (compared to 4,800 visitors last year).





The visitors were mainly senior secondary students and junior secondary students.




Over half of the visitors (or the visitors' children) attend a <u>local public school or a local private school</u> (including Direct Subsidy Scheme schools).



There was an increase in the percentage of visitors (or visitors' children) who were currently studying at a local private school compare with last year.


Visitor feedback




