Highlights


There were

67 BOOTHS, 69 INSTITUTIONS, 4 SPONSORS AND 3,668 PARENTS AND STUDENTS



The visitors were mainly senior secondary students or the parents of senior secondary students.




Visitor preferences




Visitor feedback

There was both an online and a printed survey that the visitors could fill in during the exhibition. After completing the survey, the visitors could collect an exhibition souvenir. The questions were designed to gather quantitative data (statistics) and qualitative data (remarks) that would help us understand what visitors thought of the exhibition and the latest market trend.




