Thank you for your participation at the Study UK International Schools Tour and Mini Fair in Ghana on 13-14 September 2018 in Accra.

The report aims to provide you with a summary of the event, visitor and exhibitor feedback as well as other useful information. We trust that this report will enable you to report return on investment and assist with future decision making.

The event "**Study UK International Schools Tour**" hosted representatives from 10 UK universities and six Internationals schools in Accra and Tema (listed below in the Exhibitors' feedback section) who participated in the schools tour.

The "**Mini Fair**" hosted these **10 UK university** representatives who positively engaged with prospective students, professionals and parents in Tema and Accra, providing them with information on the studying opportunities and subject choices in the UK. It targeted prospective students, parents, guardians, workers and school counselors seeking information and educational opportunities for themselves.

The events helped to build brand awareness for Study UK and the UK universities who took part in the events. Our social media campaign (details listed below in the Marketing section) also provided awareness and publicity for the events.

The mini fair attracted over **400 visitors** due to the marketing campaign. Alongside the fair, series of presentations were delivered including a presentation on IELTS and Scholarships.





53.5% students, 18.3% professionals, 28.2% other 64.29% male, 35.71% female







1. What is your current status?

2. How old are you?




3. Are you male or female?






4. What programme of study are you interested in?








Marketing – Digital Promotion Reach

- A Facebook live session was held






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Exhibitor's Feedback


At the International schools tour there were <u>10 unique exhibitors</u> from UK HEIs and <u>6 Ghanaian international schools</u> in participation.

When exhibitors were asked "Will you be attending a similar exhibition next year?" <u>83.33% said yes, 16.17% are undecided.</u>




Was the (calendar) timing of this event right for you?




What was your primary market interest for this event (tick all that apply)




Have you been to any non-British Council organised events in Ghana previously?

Future steps

There are a number of areas that both the British Council and the UK institutions can work on to improve the overall arrangement and outcomes of the exhibition. The main findings and recommended steps are outlined below:

British Council

• Going forward, British Council will consider more international schools during the international schools tour.

UK Institutions

- It is suggested that institutions invite their alumni to sit with them at their stands and share real life experiences with the prospective applicants
- It is suggested that institutions read the Exhibition Handbook and also take note of their itinerary provided in their welcome pack and emails sent ahead of time
- Many visitors commented that scholarships opportunities were very low. We recommend
 institutions to look at ways of providing some sort of scholarship or discount and highlight
 these during future exhibitions

The above points, though important, should not detract from what was a successful exhibition. The upcoming exhibition (Currently Scheduled for February 2019) will build upon the lessons learned and prove even more popular. We hope to see you there!
