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

China's growth is steadily cooling...




...but some areas will see relatively stronger growth


GDP growth 2015-2020 (forecast)


#### I. China macro trends: Urbanisation

China's fastest growth is taking place in some unfamiliar places






From demographic dividend....





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### Schools for the children of foreign workers (international schools)

- Primarily serve the expatriate community
- Only permitted to admit non-Chinese nationals, though some Chinese families that hold dual citizenship skirt these regulations
- Must be approved by Education authorities and Foreign Affairs Department
- Demand peaked several years ago and is now in decline


### Local private international school

- Aimed at local Chinese
- Teaches a foreign curriculum like AP, International Baccalaureate or A-Levels
- Usually at high school level (15-18) –students have to follow the Chinese curriculum during compulsory education
- Students generally enrol with the specific aim of getting into an overseas university

### International class as part of a public high school

- A "school within a school"
- As with local private international schools, students generally enrol to get into overseas universities more easily
- Due to a fast growth and mixed quality, Beijing, Shanghai and Guangzhou have placed a moratorium on new classes


Interest in international schools surged in 2013


Available data show growth in UK-bound mobility at the schools level











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Developed, coastal regions tend to have better English capability








#### Top cities by average income\*



#### IV. Conclusions

#### For recruitment...

- If you have just one stop on your itinerary, Beijing is still the most attractive
- Shanghai and Guangzhou trail closely behind
- For smaller institutions that have lower brand profile, there may be opportunities further down the list

#### IV. Conclusions

#### For local delivery, lots of opportunities... and restrictions



First nine years of education is compulsory



If not teaching Chinese curriculum, only foreign passport holders can attend



Curricula are subject to government regulation



Must have Chinese partner
