



ABOUT US

Tiritose is a non-profit organisation established with the purpose of reconstructing Zimbabwe through the exchange of ideas, information, and skills. This exchange is aimed at taking Zimbabwe out of the isolation from resources, good healthcare and communicating with the world it has been facing. We achieve this through three main verticals:

Study Abroad Exchange Programmes: Facilitate bilateral exchange programmes between Zimbabwean institutions of higher learning and similar international institutions. Exchange programmes include:

1. Semester study abroad
2. Short-term winter or summer programmes (lasting between 2-8 weeks)

Exchange programmes may either be led by faculty of the sending institution or may be customised and designed by Tiritose in collaboration with local field experts in the respective country. Experiential learning and courses taken abroad may either be credit bearing or not, and this is determined by the home / sending institution.

Volunteering: Send Zimbabweans for placements abroad and facilitate placements for foreign nationals at matched organisations within Zimbabwe.

Internships / Experiential Learning: Receive international students and send out Zimbabwean students seeking experience at international organisations.

How it works

1. Typically, a partner institution enters into an agreement with Tiritose for two-way exchange programmes in line with the three (3) main lines of operation i.e. study abroad, volunteering and internships, and across all academic or professional fields.
2. Tiritose becomes the logistics partner for the partner institution, arranging pre-departure & in-country orientation for students on exchange, including its robust health & safety workshops. Tiritose also arranges accommodation, course-related field trips, as well as other excursions, all with a focus on keeping the students and faculty safe.
3. Partner institutions may make contact with Tiritose via email: info@tiritose.org, to start a conversation regarding exchange programmes and individual students may apply online: <http://www.tiritose.org/apply-online.html>.
4. Programme fees are administered by Tiritose for both faculty-led and individual student enrollment to a Tiritose programme. Such fees vary, depending on several factors including time of year for proposed travel, duration of programme among others. For faculty-led programmes, Tiritose sends a 'needs analysis form in order to determine costing. And for students enrolling individually, the application form and subsequent communication with the applications team will assist with determining the cost.
5. For credit bearing courses or work placements, Tiritose facilitates the transfer of credit process between the home and host institution.
